MERCHANT FAMILY BATHROOMS

Conceptualization: Mr. & Mrs. Merchant approached Pentaspace Interiors+AAPL with a dream to create a residence that would mirror their persona and possess individuality. A specific feature they looked forward to was incorporating luxuriating restrooms in their home with a distinctive feel for each space. Hence, three disparate designs for the Master Bathroom, the children's bathroom and the guest bathroom were chosen. The master bathroom was created with a rustic look in order to compliment the master bedroom design and splitting it into a dry and wet area ensured optimal space utilization. The dado (lower part of the wall) of the dry area involved textured paint while that of the wet area used vitrified solid color tiles. To add a touch of exotica, a washbasin counter-top made of laminum tile and a wash basin made from a one piece natural grey and black polished Italian stone were installed.

Elements: For the children's bathroom they used wooden textured anti-skid tiles to make the space look cozy and restful. Colorful designer tiles on the highlighter wall were used to induce elegance alongside a sense of style and



bearing in mind this bathroom was to be used by kids, a bit of a fun element was thrown-in, using a washbasin in colored fiberglass. The guest bathroom posed a design challenge due to its compactness but using a single color throughout created the illusion of a larger area. In this restroom too, a one piece Italian stone wash basin with a rough finish was plugged to evoke a naïve and homely feel. All the three washrooms exuded a different charm and turned out to be in absolute tandem with the modern family's needs and aspirations.
