The Head office building for Thyrocare Technologies Limited is based on green office planning concepts. Large office floor plates, common social breakout green spaces, appropriate orientation and floor plate widths form the basis of the design. Intermittent and overlooking terraces are the core of the building design.

The building is oriented to ensure shaded facades and maximize natural light. Terraces are introduced at intermittent levels to act as courtyards and double up as gathering spaces. These terraces bring in soothing morning light and help cut away the harsh afternoon light. Thus becoming the central area for interaction. The terrace faces the east to bring in the early morning sunlight, while the west facade has minimal opening to cut out the harsh afternoon sunlight. A break in the mass of the building makes it look lighter and allows some green in an otherwise glass-faced

architecture. A slight tilt in the east facade adds to the drama in the building form, and also acts as a self-shading tool.

The design succeeds in creating small yet important spaces for interaction. Large and geometric column grids allow flexibility in office interior design.
